NOTE: The standard hi-limit thermostat (806-7545) can be used without modification on most fryers. The connectors provided with this kit allow the hi-limit to be modified for installation in the remainder of the fryers.

- 1. Drain the oil in the frypot below the level of the hi-limit thermostat.
- 2. Remove the hi-limit from the frypot. Refer to the Service Manual for the particular fryer for detailed removal instructions.
- 3. Remove the hi-limit wire leads from the wire harness one at a time. If neccessary, replace the connector on the replacement hi-limit to match the connector on the old hi-limit.

NOTE: Crimp and solder the new connectors to the hi-limit leads.

- 4. Install the new hi-limit in the frypot using the LoctiteTM provided to achieve a proper seal.
- 5. If present, install sleeve insulation over the hi-limit leads and reconnect the leads to the wire harness, making sure they are fully seated and the wiring is routed and secured to prevent snagging or interference with other components.
- 6. Refill the fryer and test for proper operation.
